

# **Egress (Go) Bag Contents**

Egress (Go) bags are an essential part of an emergency evacuation plan. It is recommended that you inspect the bag regularly and become familiar with its contents. You should add any additional items that you feel are relevant. Take the Egress (Go) bag with you in case of an emergency evacuation.

#### • 1 Water bottle

#### • 1 Flashlight

Basic flashlight to utilize in an emergency situation, e.g., light source to identify persons, guide out of an emergency incident, used as a point of location reference for 1st Responders.

#### • 8 Light Sticks

Chemical light sticks that provide light when none is available. Open and bend to activate.

# 2 Survival Wrap Blankets

Aluminum blankets that retain available body heat in cold periods and reflect intense heat in hot periods.

#### • 1 Multi tool

Multipurpose tool for general purpose functions, e.g., pliers, screw driver.

# • 2 24" Bungee Cords

Used to secure items.

#### • 1 Permanent Marker

Writing marker used to outline plans; write on doors to let 1st Responders know your location.

#### • 1 Panel Marker

Used to place on ground or office window to identify person's location to 1st Responders for rescue.

# • 1 Roll of Duct Tape, 2" Gorilla Type 60

Multipurpose tape used to adhere items together, or tear off and make large letters to gain attention of 1st Responders. Can be used to place on Panel Marker in large bold words.



#### • 1 Smoke Emitter

Used to emit smoke to identify a person's location to 1st Responders.

#### • 1 Flexible Bernzomatic lighter

Used to heat or start a small fire in cold weather.

# • 1 Nano flashlight

High strength miniature LED light provides light; can be placed on a keychain.

#### • 1 Whistle

Allows for 1st Responders to determine presence for rescue.

#### • 100 Miniature Cable ties

General purpose to hold items together or separate items for specific use.

# • 2 Disposable Respirator N95 masks

Full facemask respirator to minimally protect a person from smoke and dust.

# • 1 Breakaway High Visibility Vest

Visually identify your presence in low light environments.

#### • 10 Hand Warmers-10 Foot Warmers

Keeps hands and feet warm up to 8 hours in cold weather.

# • 1 Individual First Aid Kit (IFAK)

Basic first aid items that assist in binding minor wounds during an emergency incident.

# 2 Vaseline Gauze packs

Applied to puncture wounds.

# • 1 Meal, Ready-to-Eat (MRE)

High Carbohydrate meal for one individual, for one day until 1St Responders arrive.
